This is our oldest established church in the Webster County Association, they were established as a church in 1842.

They are a very active church both within the church by taking trips as a group and in supporting missions. Trips coming up are to the Creation Museum and to the Ark Encounter. Some of the missions they are involved with are Choices Pregnancy Center, Freeway Ministries,, Back to School Supplies for children. Soon they will be helping to support **Kaitlyn Ledford** in the mission of Missionary with Nightlight.

This church is a completely autonomous church which means that as the church feels led to minister to anyone in the world, they do it! They seek to meet people where they are and help them know Christ or help them grow in their relationship with Christ if they are already believers. This church is led by the **Lord** and Pastored by Todd Forman.

Pastor Todd Forman has been the shepherd of this church since August of 2020. This church started with 8 charter members in a 12 by 12 foot log building and was known as Union Church. In 1857 they voted to change the name to Timber Ridge. They have gone through rebuilds and several additions ,until April 5, 2009 when the members voted to purchase 10 acres of land and build the current Church building. It is their prayer that this building be used as a tool in doing God's work reaching the lost in their community. Let us all agree in this prayer for them.
